



(1, 2.), My flat, My daily routine (1,2.), Who are we and where are we from?, What time is it?, Holidays in Latvia, Unexpected meeting, At the bus stop, In the new apartment, Where are we going on vacation?, We are buying an apartment, City Festival, Interview, Drive slower, Weather forecast for the week, At work, In the countryside, Midsummer day (Jāņi).*



Interactive material *Conversation*




Interactive material *Reading*

The study material is intended for improving the pronunciation and spelling of the Latvian language.


