## **Context and purpose**

In 2024 and 2025, the European Commission's Directorate-General for Structural Reform Support (DG REFORM) and the Organisation for Economic Co-Operation and Development (OECD) and will support the Latvian Ministry of Education and Science and Latvian higher education institutions and research organisations as they navigate the complex reform process of institutionalising new approaches to academic career development, including doctoral education. This project funded by the European Union through the European Union's Technical Support Instrument will be implemented by the OECD's Higher Education Policy Team. It aims to support Latvia to manage the structural change and provide advice to Latvian institutions according to their specific needs and capacities. The TSI project follows from the recently completed initiative funded by the Structural Reform Support Programme (SRSP) also managed by DG REFORM that proposed a new academic careers framework for Latvia. The SRSP project was implemented by the World Bank and developed through consultation with stakeholders from across Latvia's higher education and research system.
