

Deliverables of the project



Detailed **information** on reform implementation and perceptions of staff working in the higher education and research sector (through the readiness report and progress reports)

Advice from the Project Team and international experts on actions and processes that can support successful reform implementation (through the international workshops, meetings and progress reports)



A **roadmap** that lays out steps and actions that can support and sustain the success of the Latvian academic career reforms.

A sustainable community for academic staff to work together on issues of common interest, share experiences and practices and provide practitioner input into policy development. An essential component of the reformed higher education and research landscape in Latvia, in line with (and driving?) best international practice Proposal: two-phase establishment of the Community of Practice







1. Establish an initial mode of operation for the inception phase

- It is proposed that the Council of Higher Education take overall responsibility for the inception phase
- The TSI project team will support and advise the Council as needed and provide resources for some of the initial activities

Proposal: steps and timeline for Community establishment



Inception phase (June 2025 – February 2026)

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2. Experiment with and evaluate different activities, for example....

- Advisory workshops addressing key staff challenges and capacities (e.g. wellbeing, creativity in research, supervision of research students)
- Advisory session on governing and organising collaborative initiatives, with international experts
- "Town Hall" style meetings with academic staff or "requests for input" on reform issues
- First annual practice exchange conference for Latvian academic staff, hosted by a university (as the final event of the TSI project?)

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3. Refine the proposal for permanent establishment of the Community

- Further deliberations on: Name and identity (Alma Latvia?), Resourcing, Governance, most beneficial activities
- TSI final project report could outline the refined proposal for permanent establishment (February 2026)
