- Political and Social Sciences

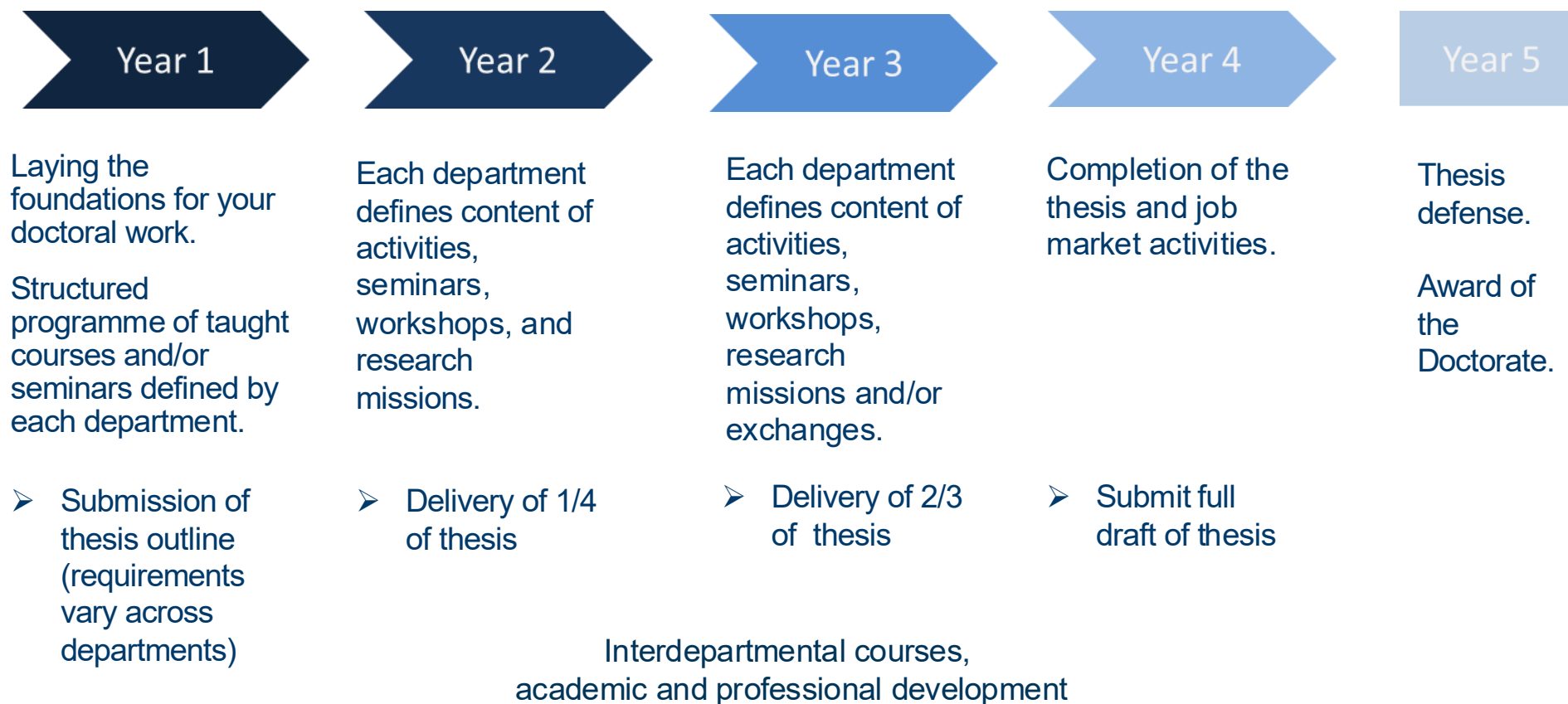

- First generation initiative

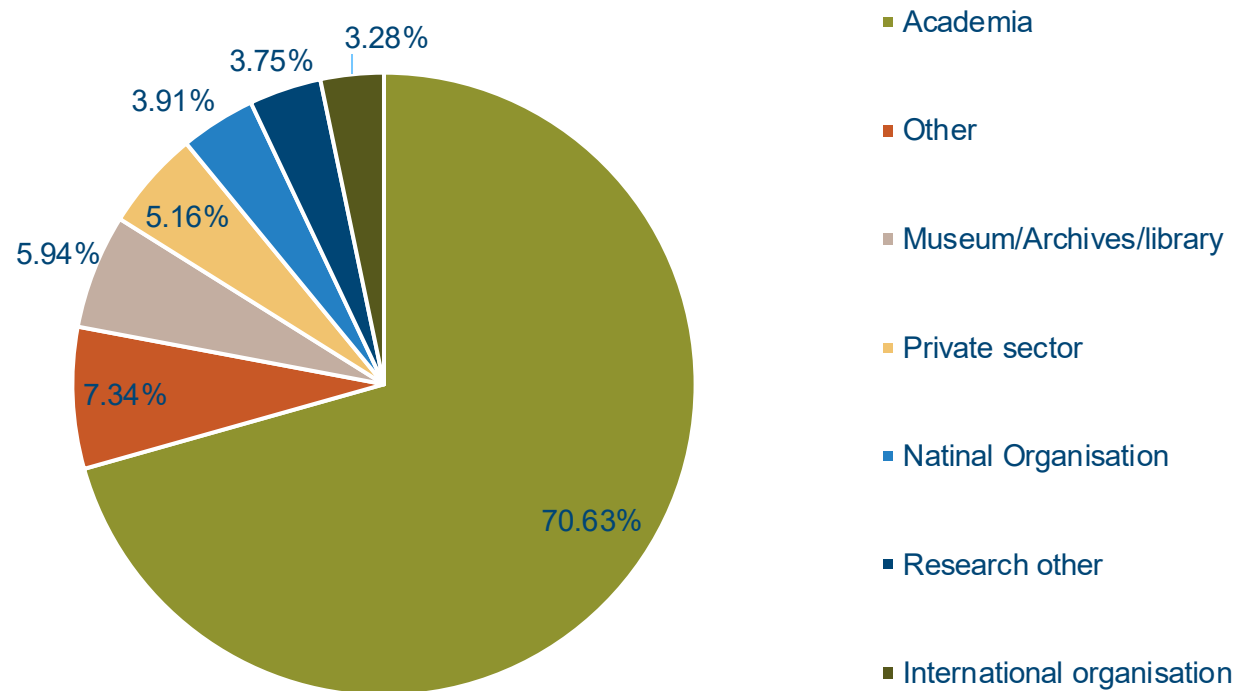
Academic and Professional Development

- Funded Research Missions
 - Up to two funded research missions (i.e. missions for archival research) per academic year in the first 3 years of the PhD programme
 - Research missions lasting up to 2 months
 - In addition, possibility to request funding for conference missions from the 2nd year of the PhD programme

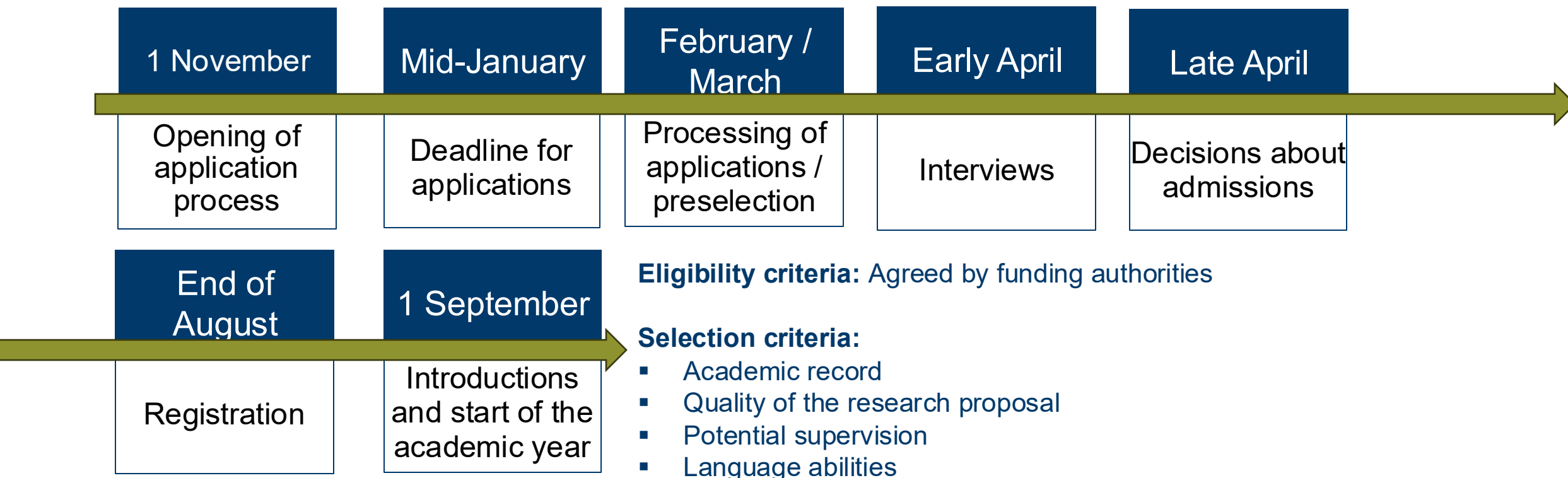
