## Structured PhD Programme

Year 1

Laying the

foundations for your doctoral work.

Structured programme of taught courses and/or seminars defined by each department.

 Submission of thesis outline (requirements vary across departments) Year 2

Each department defines content of activities, seminars, workshops, and research missions.

Delivery of 1/4 of thesis

Year 3

Each department defines content of activities, seminars, workshops, research missions and/or exchanges.

Delivery of 2/3 of thesis

Year 4

Completion of the thesis and job market activities.

Submit full draft of thesis

Year 5

Thesis defense.

Award of the Doctorate.

## Structured PhD Programme

- Close supervision with regular monitoring to assess teaching and quality of supervision
- PhD Programme governed by
  - Academic rules and regulations
  - Code of Supervision
  - Code of Ethics in Academic Research
  - Data Protection Practice in Research

## Academic and Professional Development

- Funded Research Missions
  - Up to two funded research missions (i.e. missions for archival research) per academic year in the first 3 years of the PhD programme
  - Research missions lasting up to 2 months
  - In addition, possibility to request funding for conference missions from the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the PhD programme


